10 THINGS YOU CAN DO TO PREVENT POLLUTION FROM STORMWATER RUNOFF:

-  **1.** Never dump anything down storm drains – especially pool water
-  **2.** Use rain barrels or rain gardens to capture rain water runoff
-  **3.** Don't litter – trash can end up in our creeks and streams
-  **4.** Use fertilizer only when necessary and do not over fertilize
-  **5.** Use non-toxic pesticides, follow labels and learn how to prevent pest problems
-  **6.** Service your septic tank on a regular basis
-  **7.** Pick up your pet's waste
-  **8.** Recycle used motor oil
-  **9.** Check your car for leaks
-  **10.** Wash your car on your lawn or take your car to a carwash
