

Itea virginica 'Henry's Garnet'

'Henry's Garnet' Virginia Sweetspire



Fragrant, white flower spikes, 3-6" long, cover the shrub with bloom in early summer. Dark green leaves turn scarlet and crimson in fall, sometimes persisting on the shrub until December. 'Henry's Garnet' is noted for larger flowers and superior fall color to that of the species.

Benefits:

- Fragrant white flowers attracts butterflies and other pollinators
- Stunning fall color for many weeks
- Provides protective cover for wildlife
- Tolerant of a surprising range of conditions from boggy to dry soils

Homeowner Growing and Maintenance Tips

Very easy to grow.

Adapts to a wide range of conditions including full sun to part shade and moist to dry soil.

Can spread to form colonies by root suckering if left unchecked.

Native Range

Swamps and wet woods in the coastal plain from southern New Jersey and eastern Pennsylvania to Florida and Louisiana, then north along the Mississippi to southern Illinois.

Native Trivia
